## Another title in David Hayes' Great Season

# David's Title Once More as Hayes Family Dominates

**T**he Hayes family took five of the titles as Cippenham players once again dominated the Slough Closed Championships on Leap Day and retained all the major titles. 15-years old David Hayes, the Irish junior number one, was again the star retaining his Men's Singles, Boys' Singles and Junior Doubles titles and adding the Mixed Doubles also. It was quite a family affair as David partner mother Sue to victory in the Mixed and sister Catherine in the Juniors'. For good measure Sue also won the Ladies' Singles.

David's opponent in the Men's Singles final was Cippenham Outlaws player Mike Rhodes, the champion in 2000 and 2001. The young David is now too fast for the veteran Mike but then the only game David did lose en route to the title was when another veteran Graham Trimming took the first game in the quarter-final. David's semi-final victim was John Barclay while Mike got past Clive Dawson, a Second Division player from Burnham, who had a string of good wins to reach that position including defeating fourth seed Dave Bull.

Mike got more reward for a hard day's work by winning the Veterans' Singles and Men's Doubles. The veterans' title was Mike's eighth in the past nine years and he thereby eclipsed Frank Earis' record of seven wins in the competition. Mike beat John Barclay in the final and the two beaten semi-finalists were Dave Bull and Graham Trimming.

Sylvana Bielec won a couple of events, the Junior Girls Singles and the Cadet Singles, each time beating Catherine Hayes into second place.

Nine-years old Eddie Mitchell, celebrating becoming the latest Cippenham protégé to be called up for England Schools, also had a successful day. Eddie won the Under-13 Singles and was runner-up in the Junior Doubles and the Handicap Singles. In the latter event Eddie, despite receiving a large handicap, was not quite able to cope with the unorthodox style of Chalfont's Jochen Hadder but had previously caused a stir by beating the Men's Singles champion David Hayes 13-11 in the fifth and deciding game.

Further success came Cippenham's way when Walter Aldridge beat Laurence Orton in the final of the Division 3 Singles.

## David Leads the Cippenham Charge at the Bucks Closed

Cippenham's 15-years old star David Hayes added yet another title to his already full collection when he won the Men's Singles at the Buckinghamshire Closed Championships. David, the Slough champion, deposed the reigning champion Robert Hansell in the tournament at Milton Keynes. David then teamed up with his mother, Sue Hayes to claim the Mixed Doubles while Sue gained a second title in the Women's Singles. The runner-up in the latter event, Jane Dickens, gained some consolation by winning the Women's Doubles. Robert teamed up with Mark Jackson to win the Men's Doubles and Mike Rhodes ensured a clean sweep for Cippenham players at the championships by winning the Veteran Men's Singles and the Veterans' Doubles.

## Girls B Team Win JBL Div 2

Cippenham Girls "B" team completed their domination of Division 2 of the Junior British League when the final stage of the competition was held at Aldersley during Valentine's weekend. The two point lead taken from the first weekend in November was extended to five as Cippenham returned a 100% record from their five matches. Star of the show was England number three-ranked cadet Melanie Farquhar whose hard work training with Cippenham Head Coach Ken Phillips lately was rewarded with another fine performance. Over the season Melanie won 18 of her 20 matches while Sylvana Bielec and Caroline Linz were not far behind with 14 and 12 wins respectively.

Cippenham started with a 4-2 win over Grove "C" and then followed this up with a similar scoreline against Draycott & Long Eaton "B". Melanie suffered her only defeat of the weekend in this match but Caroline got her brace to ensure an extension to Cippenham's winning run. Saturday finished on a high with a 6-0 drubbing of Hilton and after a night's rest this was followed by a 5-1 win over Scotland and a final 6-0 victory over The Weald.

The Girls "A" team maintained their fifth position in the Premier Division, beating fourth place Wirral in the final match 4-2 to leapfrog Grove "C" and get away from bottom place. Gemma Chapman signed off her junior days in this match with two wins while Welsh recruit Sarah Hall and local girl Emily Tucker won one each in a fine team performance. Earlier in the weekend results had not been so good but that was expected from a

team that, by ranking, only just qualified for the top echelon. The other four matches were all lost: 4-2 to Grove "B", 5-1 to Team Peniel "A" and 6-0 to both the top two teams Grove "A" and Oakbank Fastbats "A".

The young Girls "C" team performed very well in their first season in the British League. Up and coming starlet Katie Rule and the only slightly more experienced Catherine Hayes both won half of their 20 matches over the season while Jenny Hansell won five times. A draw against Darlington "B" and a 4-2 loss to Stafford saw Cippenham drop one place from sixth to seventh in the first stage of Division 3. The division was then split into two halves and Cippenham's fortunes improved. The second stage saw the local team improve its position to second in the bottom half with a 4-2 win over Rotherham Scorpions and 3-3 draws with Darlington "B" and St. Andrews.

The boys' team also had a good weekend, improving their position from sixth to fourth in Division 1. Chris Hansell finished top of the team's averages with 57% while Rob Lemon obtained 50%, Marc Armstrong 44% and James Milton 42% during the season. The weekend started with a loss 4-2 against divisional winners Irish Boys and then produced a startling 5-1 victory over third placed Grove "B". Saturday finished satisfactorily with a 3-3 draw against Devon Aces. Sunday started badly with a 5-1 reverse against Southfields Elite but finished on a high note with a 6-0 thrashing of rivals London Progress "B".

## Veterans Maintain Their Position

Despite the absence once again of star player Clive Payne through injury, the Cippenham veteran men's team just about managed to hold on to third place in Division 1 as the Veterans' British League concluded in Doncaster over the weekend of 6/7 February. Cippenham finished way off the pace for promotion, a full nine points behind the second placed team and only one point above the relegation zone after a weekend that yielded only two more points to add to the haul from the first weekend in November.

The weekend started badly with a 6-0 defeat at the hands of Graham Spicer despite the fact that Cippenham number one Terry Haley lost both of his matches deuce in the fifth and Paul Baker lost one of his 11-9 in the fifth. This was an inauspicious start against a team that ultimately

fell into the relegation zone. The other two Saturday matches did not produce much relief as Terry's 3-0 win over David Randall was all Cippenham could muster from a 5-1 defeat to BATTs Racquetsports and a 6-0 loss to eventual champions Thompson Insurance.

Sunday morning brought more cheer with a 6-0 drubbing of bottom team Shamrocks even though the victory over the Irish team was not as clear cut as the score suggests. Three sets were won 3-2 and the other three 3-1. Terry, Mike Rhodes and Paul Baker all shared in the success. The final match of the season brought disappointment in the form of a 4-2 defeat to Bat & Ball with Terry beating Karl Bushell and Paul beating Peter Radford to put Cippenham 2-1 up. Mike then went 2-0 up on Radford in the final set but could not turn that advantage into

the win that would have secured an additional point for Cippenham.

## Buccaneers and Vagabonds Set Up Unique Treble Possibility

Cippenham Table Tennis Club has completed two parts of what could be a unique treble. Already, Buccaneers and Vagabonds have won Divisions 2 and 3 of the Slough League and if Rogues can grab the Division 1 title, as surely they will, it will be the first time that any club has won the top three divisions outright in the League's history that dates back to 1931. Rogues currently enjoy a two-point lead over their main rivals for the championship Chalfont Argonauts but have two matches in hand.

Cippenham Buccaneers won Division 2 by eight clear points from Burnham Leopards despite an injury to captain Jeremy Bateman that kept him out of the last part of the season. Sue Hayes, Clive Perry and Peter Hillier were the mainstays for the Buccaneers with John Lloyd also getting vital wins and junior Oliver Shaw weighing in with twelve wins from as many matches as he helped out at the end of the season. Despite the final eight-point advantage this division was in the balance until the final couple of weeks of the season.

This was not the case in Division 3 as this produced a cakewalk for the Vagabonds who made up for the disappointment of last year's relegation by bouncing back at the first attempt and only dropped two points all season. The winning margin over Cippenham
