Six do Cippenham Proud in the Cadet Masters

Six Cippenham players competed in the National Cadet Masters at their home club during the weekend of 8/9th April. The thirty-two players came from all over England to compete for an event which is second only in prestige to the national championships.

The best performances came from Joanna Parker and Bradley Evans while Gemma Chapman and Thomas Mitchell were also well to the fore. Of the other Cippenham players Warren Brooks was not well enough to continue on the second day while Gemma Hollett failed to make it past the cut on the Saturday.

Last season's national under-12 champion Joanna Parker started the weekend in fine form, winning six of her seven matches on Saturday, losing only to eventual runner-up Kate Steward. Gemma Chapman, on the other hand, was disappointed to lose three times although she did have two of the top three players to contend with.

The following day, however, was better for Gemma who lost only twice more, including one against Cippenham team mate Joanna. Jo eventually finished fourth, one place ahead of Gemma, and just outside of the medal positions. In her last match Jo stunned the champion Georgina Walker, who has appeared in the full England team in the European League this season, by taking the first game and forcing the desperate Walker to take a timeout when 10-7 down in the second.

Bradley Evans, at ten years of age, was the youngest qualifier for this under-14 competition and did extremely well to finish eighth of the sixteen starters. His three wins (plus a walkover) on Saturday included one against Warren Brooks and he

retained this form into the Sunday when he beat Thomas Mitchell amongst others. Tom finished one place below Bradley in ninth spot.

The eventual winners were Greg Baker (Warwickshire) and Georgina Walker (Nottinghamshire).

Cippenham's Bradley Evans has had a busy month in April. Apart from his participation in the National Cadet Masters (see above) he also played in the England Schools Individual Championships and in the British Primary Schools Championships in Wales over the weekend 28-30th.

In the latter event Bradley played in the England U11 boys' team which won the event, beating Scotland and Isle of Man both 10-0, Wales 8-2 and Ireland 6-4. Bradley then went on the win the Boys' Singles with a win in the final over Liam Thomas of Wales.

Bradley was successful in winning the U11 Boys' Singles while three other Cippenham stars reached the semi-finals of their competitions - Gemma Chapman in the U16 Girls' Singles and Joanna Parker and Emily Tucker both in the U13 Girls' Singles.

All have qualified to represent England Schools and our congratulations go especially to Emily for whom this is a first international recognition.

Wycombe High School Success at Grantham

Wycombe High School finished runners-up at this year's national team finals, an improvement of one place on their finish last year. The U16s side fought through county, regional and area rounds to reach the three-team finals at Grantham for the second successive year.

And Wycombe got sweet revenge on the team who had pushed them into third place last year when they saw off Cumbria's Parkview School with a resounding 6-2 victory. Francesca Parnell gave Wycombe an early advantage with a narrow 23-21 win before Katherine Tweedy doubled the score. Wycombe dropped just two matches but victories for Alex Hedley (2), Sarah Downie and Francesca saw them home. Holders Peniel Academy proved a different kettle of fish though as Wycombe were thumped 8-0 by the top table tennis school.

Gemma and Jo Star for England

Cippenham's Gemma Chapman and Joanna Parker were both in dominant form for England in the Home Countries International Championships at Largs (Scotland) on April 26/27th. Gemma was in superb form as she won all of her matches in England's success in the junior category while Jo did likewise in the cadet section. England beat Wales and Scotland both 5-0 in the juniors, their only blemish being a doubles defeat in the 4-1 win over Ireland. The England cadet team romped away 5-0 in every match.

Joanna also won the Cadet Girls' Singles event while Gemma, while unwell, succumbed to an Irish girl in the quarter-finals.

Both girls have both been chosen to represent England cadets in the forthcoming Spanish Open Championships and the European Youth Championships.

Dilger Cup Success for Rogues

Cippenham Rogues brushed aside the disappointment of their failure in the Slough League promotion play-off match to gain consolation with success in the Dilger Cup Final at Burnham on 25th April.
