

NEW SPONSORSHIP DEAL SIGNED WITH JARVIS SPORTS

Cippenham Table Tennis Club has signed up a new two-year sponsorship deal with Guildford based table tennis specialists Jarvis Sports. Club Chairman Ken Phillips, the man responsible for brokering the deal on behalf of the Club, said he was "delighted" to continue with Jarvis and Nicky Jarvis, the former England international and proprietor of Jarvis Sports, was equally happy.

The deal is a good one for both parties. The Club has acquired brand new playing equipment and kit for all of its coaches and British leagues teams for a fraction of the list price, while Jarvis Sports has retained the account of one of England's leading table tennis clubs.

By the time you read this, ten brand new Donic Waldner Sinus tables will have been delivered to the Centre. These tables are the top of the Donic range and retail for £850 each. Unlike the existing Persson tables, the two halves fold together in one unit. This should protect the playing surface much better. For the first year general use at the Centre will continue on the existing Donic Persson tables with the Sinus table being brought out for ETTA events and open tournaments; in fact the general rule will be any competition within the ETTA ranking scheme. Explained Club Secretary Graham Trimming, "We have the best table tennis centre in the country and it is imperative that we maintain the standard of our equipment. The plan is to continuously change tables every two years or so so that we always have quality equipment available for the big events."

Second teams entered in British leagues

Following on from the success last season for the main British League team and the Women's British League team, both of whom won their divisions and gained promotion, second teams have this season been entered in each category. In total this means that the Club will run eight teams in British league competitions and is on course in its objective to provide a pathway through all the leagues for our developing players.

Martin Adams (ranked 130 in England) and Clive Payne (189) have been signed to play in the British League first team along with Kimber Choda (182) and Martin Rule (257). This team will operate in Division 2 South. Steve Joel and Sue Collier also remain from last year's team and form the nucleus of the second team, which will play in Division 3 South & West, captained by Paul Baker. Also in the squad are Mike Rhodes, Nicholas Wilson, Samantha Marling and Maidenhead champion Mark Banks.

In a bid to secure further promotion into the top echelon of the Women's British League the Club has signed England number 11 and Under-21 champion Shelley Ruocco to play alongside Sue Collier (10) and the Club's Estonian World veterans champion Kai Milvek. Claire Plumridge will be the fourth member of the squad while the second team will be captained by Jacquie Lovell and will provide Sue Hayes, Gemma Chapman and Jane Dickens with experience at this higher level. Shelley is unavailable for the first series of matches on September 12/13th but hopefully the remaining ladies can put up a good enough performance to make promotion a possibility when at full strength in January.

As star performer Gareth Herbert is no longer a junior, the Club has gone outside of its local membership to secure the services of Kent's Stephen Beerling (ranked 19) to ensure Premier Division status in the Woolwich Junior British League. The first boys' team will be spearheaded by Martin Rule (14) with Beerling second and Nicholas Wilson (35) making up the team. The second team will consist of Robert Hansell, Warren Brooks and Marc Gilston. The girls will be almost as last season with Gemma Chapman, Jane Dickens and Emma Human, while for the veterans, newcomer Paul Baker will replace Frank Earis and play alongside Mike Rhodes and Graham Trimming.

Plans to extend WNJL

After its successful introduction into the ETTA calendar last season there are moves to extend and enhance the Woolwich National Junior League this season. The format of this league is play at regional centres, including Cippenham, over four Saturdays during the season.

Last year the Southern Region section, at Cippenham, had just seven teams and was won by Cippenham's third boys' team. Attempts are being made to increase the membership to eighteen boys' teams and six girls' teams and, although it is unlikely that these ambitious goals will be reached, there will be at least two boys' divisions and at least four girls' teams. The entry from Cippenham will be either three or four boys' teams and one or two girls' teams.

The ETTA has allowed Mike Atkinson, the coach at Chesham High School, licence to organise the Southern Region competition and it is his zest, in partnership with our own Ken Phillips, which is responsible for the enhancement of the event.
