Gemma Chapman wins her fourth Cippenham Open title in less than a year

emma Chapman was once again the local star performer at the Cippenham Cadet 3 Star Open Championships on 28th March which attracted another maximum entry of 108 players. Gemma has always performed well at her home club tournaments and this was no exception, being a convincing winner of the Girls' Singles with a win in the final over Abigail Embling from Essex. In the semi-final top seed Gemma had overcome her Cippenham colleague Joanna Parker, seeded fourth, while third seed Embling had overturned the rankings with a win over second seed Grace Brown. Such was the power of Gemma's performance that she decimated a field that contained four of the top twelve players in England.

Another success for Cippenham came in the form of the emerging Emily Tucker who won her group after beating Reading's Kerry Matthews, ranked twenty places higher, then disposed of Melanie Farquhar in the second round before falling to Joanna.

The Boys' Singles went almost entirely according to seeding with England number 4 Dominic Hall (Kent) beating tenth ranked Tim Holtam (Middlesex) in the final. Cippenham's last representative was John Camilleri who justified his third seeding by reaching the semi-final, losing to Hall, while Thomas Mitchell fell one round earlier to fourth seed Neil Cartwright.

The consolation events provided Cippenham players with more glory. In the girls' final, which was an all Cippenham affair, Francesca Parnell held off the challenge of Katherine Tweedy, while Helen Smith reached the semi-final before losing to Francesca. In the boys' event Chris Hansell reached the final but lost to Liam Thomas who was one of the party that had travelled from Wales for the event. Thomas had earlier accounted for the home club's James Milton in his semi.

COMMUNITY CLUB OF THE YEAR

Cippenham Table Tennis Club picked up another award at the prestigious Mayor of Slough's Annual Sports Awards held at The Centre (not the TTC!) on 19th March. Having won the Junior Club of the Year award last year, this time is was the Community Club of the Year that came our way. This is a new award and so Cippenham TTC is the first name to be engraved on the trophy which now proudly resides in the trophy cabinet at the Club.

In the citation for the award the Club was praised for raising over £500,000 to build its own purpose built centre, the work going on in the junior section and links with local schools, especially the new partnership formed with special needs school Arbour Vale.

MIKE AND SUE WIN TITLES AT BUCKS CLOSED

Cippenham's Mike Rhodes nearly pulled off a sensational double at the Bucks Closed Championships held at Milton Keynes on 28th March. Mike won the Veteran Men's Singles beating High Wycombe's Ken Philipson 21-19 in the third game of a close final. Mike then contested the final of the Men's Singles against Brent Skuse who he had beaten easily earlier in the day in the veterans' event. This time, however, the tables were turned and Mike lost the chance to be county men's champion by the narrowest of margins at deuce in the third.

Cippenham's Sue Hayes also won an event, the Women's Doubles with Jan Curtis of High Wycombe. Sue also lost in the finals of both the Women's Singles and Mixed Doubles events.

Top seeds win the Veterans' titles



Both of the top seeds came through to win the main titles at the Cippenham Veterans' 2 Star Open Championships on 6th March. For Stephen Davis of Surrey, it was his first title at his first attempt, while for Marilyn Bawden of Essex it was her third such title.

In his final Davis overcame surprise finalist Ken Philipson in three games. The Buckinghamshire county player from Aylesbury had come though unseeded to win his group over Tony Taylor, and then won through against Mike Wilkins, the conqueror in his group of fifth seed Mike Rhodes, fourth seed Terry Guymer and seventh seed Trevor Campbell. Meanwhile Davis had disposed of Cippenham's Mike Rhodes, Norman Swift and then Tony Taylor in the semi-final.

The last surviving Cippenham members were Maurice Isaacs and Graham Outrim who both departed at the quarter-final stage. Mike Rhodes, Derek Wood and Chalfont's John Barclay were beaten one round earlier.

After struggling to win all her matches in her group, Bawden really got going in the competition proper beating Haruko Brown in the semi-final and Hampshire's Gill Larking with ease in the final.
