It's a Relegation Fight—Three Times Over

It was another disappointing weekend at the end of November for Cippenham's teams in the British League. With the half-way stage in the season now passed, all three teams are struggling at or near the foot of their divisions. In fact, the only team not actually bottom is the first team and they have less points than the second and third teams! However, it is very closely fought and a handful of good results could see all three teams leap out of trouble.

The Cippenham first team had a long trip to Okehampton in Devon, a trip that is rarely relished or profitable. This time was no different as only two points were gained from the weekend and the team sits perilously close to relegation from Division 1 South and reliant on the same sort of surge up the table as they managed last season. The first point was gained against Team Peniel II, when both Mark Butler and Martin Adams scored impressive wins against the Peniel number one, Czech import Martin Kurbt. Mark secured his brace with a win against Fred Dove while Rob Lemon came close, just losing out 11-8 in the fifth and deciding game, against an in-form Sean Gibson, who had his fair share of edge balls to close out the game. Lee Dredge bravely overcame Abigail Embling for the deserved point. The Saturday afternoon match saw Cippenham lose 1-7 to second place Woolwell, the only joy being Mark's impressive 3-0 victory over James Whiteman.

Sunday saw a repeat of Saturday in terms of results. The only point was gained against DHS Greenhouse Progress II. Once again it was Mark who impressed as he won his two matches, ably backed up by Lee and Rob with one win each. Martin lacked his usual final winner's touch as he lost out 12-10 in the fifth in his two matches having led in both. The final match of the weekend saw Cippenham outplayed by a strong Brighton squad, the only victory being for Martin against Dov Katz.

The second team had the advantage of their home venue and a solitary point was a disappointing return from the weekend's endeavours. That point was gained in the very first match with

a 4-4 draw against Carrara Polska thanks mainly to Steve Munson who won his two matches against Dan Kolesnik and Klaudia Szadkowska. Cippenham had led 3-1 after Martin Gray and Danny Baxter had also won their opening encounters. During the remainder of the weekend losses were sustained against Elgre Nottingham 2-6, Kingfisher Reading 3-5 and leaders of Division 1 South and West, Sycamore, 1-7.

Cippenham's third string, playing at the London Progress Tournament Centre in Southall, fared little better gaining two points. They both came during the Saturday afternoon match with SEH-Britannia Ipswich. Chris Hansell led the team from the front with two victories over lan Brown and Gary Young while Eddie Mitchell also won two and Steve Smith one in the final set to secure a 5-3 win.

Eddie had also won both his matches in the morning fixture against Horsham III but his team-mates offered nothing in the way of substantive help as the match was lost 2-6. Gemma Chapman and Phil Prady came into the team for the Sunday matches relieving Chris and Eddie but this had a detrimental effect on results with the previous day's two most successful players now missing. To make matters worse, Gemma succumbed to an arm muscle injury in the first match but, nevertheless, she was still Cippenham's only winner during heavy defeats suffered at the hands of Ashford II 1-7 and Crusaders 0-8


